

## **Property Tax Due Date**

- The property tax year runs from January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup> each year.
- Property tax statements are expected to be mailed end of July of each year.
- Property taxes are due on October 31<sup>st</sup> each year, subject to interest charge on unpaid amounts at 1.25% on the first day of the month after October 31<sup>st</sup>.
- With some exceptions, supplementary property taxes are due December 31<sup>st</sup> to properties that have changes in assessment due to new construction or renovations which were not reflected on the annual tax statement.
- If you do not receive your tax statement, it is possible that we do not have your current mailing address. It is your responsibility to keep your address current with us.

## **Paying Property Taxes**

1. **In person:** Cash, Debit, Cheque or Money Order can be accepted at the Municipal Office located in the St. Laurent Recreation Centre. Our address is 16 St. Laurent Veteran's Memorial Road – Office Hours are Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (open during lunch).
2. **By mail:** R.M. of St. Laurent, P.O. Box 220, St. Laurent, MB R0C 2S0
3. **Online:** Set up a payment option for property taxes with your financial institution, using your roll number as your account number. To do this, you must access your existing on-line bill system through your financial institutions website and add the R.M. of St. Laurent as a Payee. You will then use your Roll Number, without the decimal, as the account number (6 or 9 digits depending on the bank).
4. The RM does not offer the option of paying taxes using a credit card. However, you may be able to use a third-party service provider that offers additional payment methods, including credit cards. The provider that offers the credit card method at this time is listed below, and the third-party providers charge a fee for their services, located on our website.
